



Eleanor J. (Pugliese) Scialdone

March 2, 1921 - January 30, 2012

Mrs. Eleanor J. (Pugliese) Scialdone, of Utica, passed away on Monday, January

30, 2012 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center. Although she had lived 90

fulfilling years of life, her passing was unexpected.

Born in Witherbee, NY on March 2, 1921, Eleanor was the daughter of the late John and Virginia (Mazza) Pugliese. The family surname was also known as Ponessa. She was raised and educated in Witherbee. On November 16, 1941 she

married Joseph John Scialdone with whom she shared 41 years until his passing on

May 6, 1983; they shared a great closeness and were a truly happy couple.

For many years, Eleanor worked as an associate at the F.W. Woolworth Store located on Mohawk Street. But it was her work as a wonderful mother which won

her the honor and love of her children, and she fulfilled this precious role with much dedication. She welcomed her daughters-in-law with much love and

respect. As a grandmother she was an outstanding role model; each of her grandchildren looked forward to spending time with her. To those extended family

and friends who were fortunate enough to be embraced by her, she was

affectionately known as "Grandma El." Blessed with a generous spirit, a compassionate heart, and a soft smile upon her face, she was the heart of the family and was happiest when she spent time with them. She was an outstanding

cook with her own itinerary in preparing delicious dishes. Christmas celebrations were often hosted at her home, brimming with festivity and tradition. She kept the past alive, always supportive of the best and most challenging times of life. Her favorite present to receive was bingo lottery tickets which gave her the greatest thrills. Eleanor lived her spirituality daily, and for many years she practiced her faith at St. Agnes Parish.

Eleanor is survived by her sons and daughters-in-law, Anthony Joseph "Tony" and

Anne Marie Scialdone of New Hartford, and Joseph John "Joe", Jr. and Dale Scialdone of Marcy; her grandchildren, Anthony Joseph II and Heather Scialdone,

and Michael J. Scialdone; Joseph John Scialdone III, Christopher K. and Elizabeth Scialdone, and Gregory M. Scialdone; and her great-grandchildren, Dominic and Valentina.
