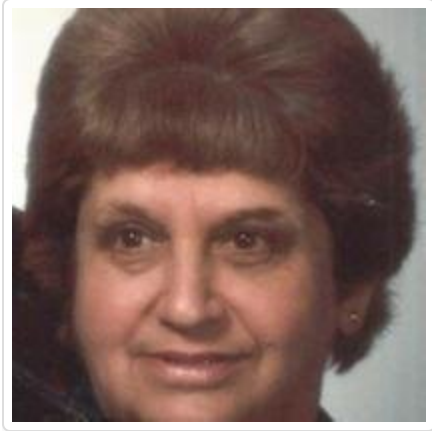




Jessie R. (Greco) Durdan
