Lisa Anne Marchitelli, age 47, of North Utica, passed away at the Faxon-St. Luke's Healthcare Center on Thursday, February 2, 2012. Her untimely passing occurred with her family by her side after she endured countless health concerns.

Lisa was born in Utica on December 18, 1964, the third daughter of Stephen P. and Arlene A. (Jones) Marchitelli. She appreciated growing up in a household where her family held pride in their Italian heritage. She was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School in 1983.

An industrious and hard-working young lady, Lisa had been employed at the Metropolitan Life Insurance Company. Over twenty years ago, she accepted a position with the UFCW Local 1, where she became part of an outstanding work family. She held the title of healthcare benefit clerk for employee benefits.

Lisa had a zest for life, forever fun loving, spirited and enthusiastic. She celebrated each day with a remarkable passion. She was an incredibly charismatic woman who was the heart of any party. When Lisa walked into a room, she was the center of its energy, as others were naturally drawn to her confidence, charm, and engaging personality. With her contagious sense of humor, quick wit, and entertaining sarcasm, Lisa brought fun and excitement into the lives of everyone she knew. She was honest and forthcoming about her insights and opinions, especially when faced with the need to protect the interest of those she loved. Lisa embraced family life; she was an affectionate

daughter, proud to be one of “five sisters” and a lighthearted and fun aunt. It was always her priority to show her loved ones how much she cherished their relationships. Perhaps one of her most endearing qualities was the generous expression of her affection toward the family and friends she loved so dearly. A truly unforgettable woman, the memories made with Lisa left deep and lasting imprints upon the hearts of all those who knew her. During her illness, she rallied and resiliently faced and acknowledged her health challenges with much courage. But, ironically, one would wonder if sometimes special people like Lisa, knew their time on this earth would be less than others. Her leisure activities included following the sport of Nascar racing, endearing herself to Dale Earnhart, Jr. She participated in “retail therapy” and looked forward to the yearly gathering with her entire family at camp in the Adirondacks. She was a parishioner of St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church.

Lisa is survived by her beloved parents, Steve and Arlene; her sisters and brothers-in-law, Lynne Anne and Brian Toussaint of Deerfield, Laurie Anne Flagg and Jim Vincent of Utica, Leslie Anne and Gaetano Spina of Frankfort, and Stephanie Anne Madia and fiance Tom Conte of New Hartford. Also left to remember her are her nieces and nephews, Brianne Toussaint, and Shane Toussaint; William “Billy” Flagg who was also her Godson, and Cara Flagg; Nino Spina, and Jake Spina; Ciara Madia, and Jordan Madia, who also shared the relationship of Godson; an aunt and uncle, Antonia and Michael Fusco; great aunts, great uncles, and cousins. She was predeceased by her maternal grandparents, Francis A. “Butch” and Amelia A. “Mal” Jones; and her paternal grandparents Frank S. and Jenny Marchitelli.
