Mrs. Agnes Rose (Carrock) Hickel, age 87, passed away on Friday, July 11, 2014 at the St. Luke's Home with the support of her family.

Born in Utica on January 30, 1927, Agnes was the daughter of the late Ameen and Sarah (Haday) Carrock. Raised and educated locally, she was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. On September 6, 1948 she married Charles H. Hickel with whom she shared 65 years; they were a happy couple and great companions who always thought of each other's needs.
