



## Mrs. Agripina "Elsa" (Guadalupe) Santiago

UTICA – Mrs. Agripina “Elsa” (Guadalupe) Santiago, age 85, passed away on Tuesday, February 27, 2024, with her loving family by her side.

Born in Penuelas, Puerto Rico on April 18, 1938, Agripina was the daughter of the late Domingo and Julia (Santiago) Guadalupe. She was raised and educated in Puerto Rico where she lived until November of 1964, when she and her family came to the United States where they have since resided.

At age 17, Elsa met Abraham Santiago, and they solidified their relationship when they wed in 1965. The couple shared 57 years together prior to his passing on January 2, 2007.

Elsa was first and foremost a loving mother. She always took care to show her children and grandchildren great affection.
