



Mr. Alexy M. Kirushin

March 17, 1922 - February 7, 2016

Alexy Michalovich Kirushin, age 93, of Utica, passed away on Sunday, February 7, 2016 in the comfort of his home with his loving family by his side. Born in Jurasow, Russia on March 17, 1922, Alexy was the son of the late Michael and Katerina (Prokopieva) Kirushin. He was raised and educated in Russia. On December 23, 1955, in Germany, he married the former Nina Freimann with whom he shared 60 years.

Alexy served with the Allied troops during WWII. After the war, he was employed by Radio Free Europe in Germany. In 1957, Alexy and Nina emigrated from Germany to the United States where they have resided ever since. In 1966, settling in Utica, he began his 19-year career in the engineering department at Mohawk Data Sciences Corporation in Herkimer, the position from which he retired in 1985. He was a member of St. John of Kronstadt Russian Orthodox Memorial Church.

Alexy is survived by his wife, Nina; his daughters and sons-in-law, Helen and John DiPietro of Raleigh, NC, and Katharine and Alan Davis of Otego, NY; his grandchildren, Thomas A. Davis, Michael A. Davis, Steven A. Davis; Michael Victor DiPietro, and Victoria Marie DiPietro. His extended family includes his nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins, and in-laws Valentina Banziger, and George and Barbara Freimann. He was predeceased by his 12 siblings.

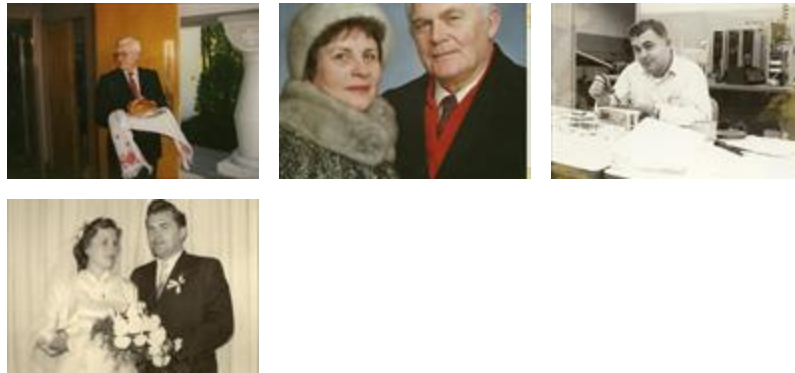

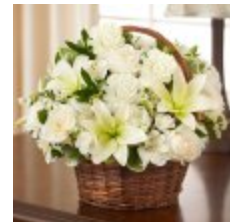

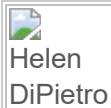
