



Anastasia "Ana" Torres

April 15, 1935 - October 8, 2010

Mrs. Anastasia "Ana" Torres, age 75, of North Utica, passed away unexpectedly on Friday, October 8, 2010 at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center with the love and support of her family by her side.

Born in Puerto Rico on April 15, 1935, Anastasia is the daughter of Gloria Maria Torres and the late Jose Martinez Torres. She was raised and educated in Puerto Rico.

Ana took pride in being the matriarch of her family, and providing for them was her priority in life.
