She was fond of shopping with her mom when Bernie wasn't available. She and her mom were companions and best of friends, and Andrea aspired to be as good a parent as her mom was to her. She will always be remembered for her goodness, generosity, and great laugh. She found happiness in her husband, fulfillment in her motherhood, and joy in each day. She was a parishioner of St. Mark's Church.
