Mrs. Angela "Ang" (Montanaro) Piacenti, age 93, joined those who went before her as she passed away on Thursday, August 11, 2016 at the Masonic Care Community of NY surrounded by her loving family.

Born in Utica on January 10, 1923, Angela was the daughter of the late Dominick and Amelia (Liuzzi) Montanaro. Raised and educated locally, she was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School/Class of 1941. On February 5, 1943 she married Mark Anthony "Tony" Piacenti, Sr. with whom she shared 57 years in a union blessed with mutual respect. Mark provided for his family and was vigilant to Ang's needs until his passing on May 8, 2000.

For 25 years, Angela held employment with the Utica City School District at T.R. Proctor High School holding various office positions until her retirement. She was beloved by co-workers and students. She was a well diversified and intellectually blessed woman with an incredible outlook on life. She enjoyed reading historical and classical literature. Ang was fierce in her love of family and her experience was a source of sound advice for them. She did not differentiate the love between the generations and considered each of them as her favorite. Her loved ones looked up to her and sought out her approval on decisions in their lives. She was a positive force in guiding them in the right direction and they will honor her memory forever. A communicant of St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church, Ang was very involved in parish activities and was a longtime member of the Assumption Society. She prayed often for those she loved most and her supplications brought her solace and

strengthened her relationship with her Savior.

Angela is survived by her daughter and son-in-law, Maria P. and Michael S. Pilla of Clinton. She held close to her heart the memory of her son, Mark Anthony Piacenti, Jr. who passed on March 11, 2016. She also leaves her beloved grandchildren, Mark C. 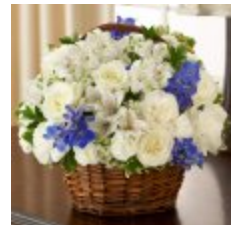
