November 20, 1917 - January 1, 2014

Miss Angelina M. Cardinale, age 96, passed away on New Year's Day, Wednesday, January 1, 2014 at the Katherine Luther Residential Health Care Center.

Born in Utica on November 20, 1917, Angelina was the daughter of the late Nicola and Rose (Dalessio) Cardinale. Raised and educated locally, she attended the Utica School of Commerce.

Angelina's career was as office manager with the New York State Department of Health, the position from which she retired in 1978. She was a past president of the Nita Kola Service Club, a member of the Civil Service Employees Association (CSEA), and of the American Association of Retired Persons (AARP). She was a communicant of Our Lady of the Rosary Church.
