



## Angeline LaPolla

February 15, 1915 - April 26, 2006

Miss Angeline LaPolla, age 91, of Utica, passed away on Wednesday, April 26, 2006 in the comfort and security of her home.

Born in Foggia, Italy on February 15, 1915, Angeline was the daughter of the late Antonio and Maria (DeFuria) LaPolla. During the early years of her childhood, her family relocated to the U.S. and settled in Utica where she was then raised and educated.

At one time Miss LaPolla was employed in the area's knitting mills, notably Oneita Knitting and Beaunit Fibers. She devoted herself to her parents and their well-being. As a natural-born caretaker, Angeline sacrificed much of her own life in order to tend the needs of her family. A communicant of St. Mary of Mt. Carmel Church, she enjoyed attending daily Mass and did so faithfully until the time when she could no longer walk from her home to the church. In fact, she will be remembered fondly by many as one of the "morning glories." Miss LaPolla is survived by 2 brothers and a sister-in-law, Louis J. LaPolla Sr. and Marion LaPolla, and John A. LaPolla, all of Utica; a number of nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, and cousins; and a brother-in-law, John Yozzi. She was predeceased by a sister, Mary Yozzi; and a sister-in-law, Evelyn LaPolla.
