



## Angeline L. (Antonucci) Damiano

May 16, 1928 - April 2, 2006

Mrs. Angeline L. (Antonucci) Damiano, age 77, formerly of St. Vincent Street, Utica, and for the past three years a resident of Morenci, Michigan where she lived with her daughter, passed away on Sunday, April 2, 2006 at the Adrian Health Care Center in Adrian MI.

Born in Utica on May 16, 1928, Angeline was the daughter of the late Carlo and Annuziata “Nancy” (Carcioni) Antonucci. She was raised here and attended local schools. After completing her secondary studies, she continued her education at the St. Elizabeth School of Nursing. At one time she was married to Armond Damiano.
