



Angeline "Lil" (Annese) Paniccia

October 13, 1914 - June 18, 2006

Mrs. Angeline "Lil" (Annese) Paniccia, age 91, of Utica, passed away peacefully on Sunday, June 18, 2006 at the St. Joseph Nursing Home. Born in Utica on October 13, 1914, Angeline was the daughter of the late Antonio and Maria (Palmisano) Annese. She was raised here and attended local schools. On April 24, 1937 she married Frank Paniccia with whom she shared a 50-year union prior to his passing on July 23, 1987.

Mrs. Paniccia was employed as an assembler at UNIVAC for more than 20 years, retiring at the time of the plant's closing.

Lil was a kind and loving woman who was admired for her caring ways. When her children began raising families of their own, she loved nothing better than welcoming all of her loved ones into her home and presenting wonderful dinners for these gatherings. She was equally as hospitable with neighbors and friends: her door was always open and she enjoyed the visits and company of all who stopped by. She was a longtime and loyal parishioner of St. Agnes Church and a devoted member of the Legion of Mary.

Mrs. Paniccia is survived by 3 daughters and sons-in-law, Mary Sue and James Hoke of Poland NY, Marlene and John Belensky of Lee Center NY, and Tonia Gail McCully of Marco Island FL; and a son and daughter-in-law, Santo "Sam" and Sandra Paniccia of Utica.
