

## Mr. Angelo B. Brindisi

December 24, 1952 - January 21, 2024

CHADWICKS, NY – Mr. Angelo B. Brindisi, age 71, passed away unexpectedly on Sunday, January 21, 2024.

Born in Utica on December 24, 1952, Angelo was the son of Flora M. (Barber) Brindisi and the late Salvatore F. Brindisi. Graduating from T.R. Proctor High School, Angelo continued his education at Mohawk Valley Community College with an Associate Degree in Accounting and SUNY Institute of Technology with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Business/Public Management.

On October 4, 1991, Angelo married the former Robin Brown, and they shared a long, happy, and loving life prior to her passing on February 11, 2022. Angelo referred to Robin as the strongest and bravest person he ever knew.

Angelo spent his career in management at local financial institutions. Most recently, he worked at Mohawk Valley Federal Credit Union. Anyone who knew Angelo knew he was an avid sports fan and followed his beloved New York Yankees and other teams closely. He especially enjoyed the yearly trips to Yankee Stadium with his daughters and sons-in-law. He also looked forward to the lively conversations he would have with his brothers when they got together.

Angelo is survived by his mother, Flora M. Brindisi; his daughters and their spouses, Sandra and Craig Johnville, and Lisa and Christopher Jones; and step-daughter and her spouse, Megan and Bernard Hyman. He also leaves to cherish his memory 6 grandchildren; brothers and sisters-in-law, Charles and Carol Ann Brindisi, and Daniel and Sheila Brindisi. Angelo was preceded by his sister and brother-in-law, Carrie Brindisi-Greene and her husband Brian. He is additionally survived by several nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, and cousins. Angelo was also predeceased by his nephew, Michael Brindisi; and a special aunt, Josephine Barber Kane.
