



## Mr. Angelo J. "Tiny" Pucine

May 30, 1938 - June 23, 2016

Mr. Angelo J. Pucine, "Tiny" to his friends and family, at age 78, passed away unexpectedly on Thursday, June 23, 2016 while he and his wife Vanessa were visiting their son and daughter-in-law in Hollywood, Florida.

Born on May 30, 1938, Angelo was the son of the late Frank A. and Theresa (Nole) Pucine.
