Ms. Anjanette Denice Buie-Hobdy, age 61, of Utica, entered into the eternal sunset on Thursday, September 22, 2016 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center with her loving family at her side.

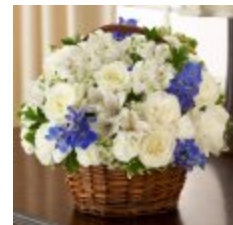

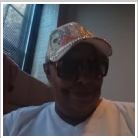
