



## Anna (Colucci) Amarosa

November 30, 1919 - August 9, 2008

Mrs. Anna (Colucci) Amarosa, age 88, of Little Falls, passed away on Saturday, August 9, 2008 at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center.

Born in Utica on November 30, 1919, Anna was the daughter of the late Donato and Theresa (Matarrese) Colucci. She was raised and educated locally. On April 23, 1938 she married Eugene J.
