Mrs. Anna R. (Rosato) Melchiorre, age 88, of Utica, passed away on Wednesday, July 13, 2011 at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center with her family by her side.

Anna was born in Utica on December 23, 1922, the daughter of the late Nicholas and Angeline (LaNeve) Rosato. She also knew the love and guidance of her stepfather, John LaPolla. She was raised and educated locally, attending T.R Proctor High School. On November 7, 1942 she married Frank J.
