



Anna M. (Grimaldi) George

Mrs. Anna M. (Grimaldi) George, age 97, of Utica, passed away on Wednesday, July 26, 2006, at the Heritage Health Care Center.

Born in Utica on March 29, 1909, Anna was the daughter of the late Constanzo and Theresa (Quilici) Grimaldi. She was raised and educated locally. On June 18, 1935 she married Edward T.
