



## Mrs. Anna "Nura" (Cigajeva) Normat

April 10, 1916 - April 5, 2011

Mrs. Anna "Nura" (Cigajeva) Normat, age 94, of Utica, passed away on Tuesday, April 5, 2011 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center with the love and support of her family by her side.

Born in Kiev, Ukraine, USSR, Anna was the daughter of the late Ivan and Katharina (Fedorowna) Cigajeva. She was raised and educated in the Ukraine and worked on the family farm in her youth. During World War II, Nura met Nursa "Moe" Normat and the couple fell in love. On May 14, 1955 they were married and the following year they traveled with British troops to Austria and began their journey to the United States. They shared 34 years prior to Moe's passing on September 27, 1989. For many years, Anna worked as a housekeeper for a local physician.

Anna is survived by her daughter, Elli Casey, of Utica. She mourned the loss of her son-in-law, Robert Casey, who passed away in 1999. She also leaves her son and daughter-in-law, Joseph and Elizabeth "Liz" Leone-Normat of Utica; her grandchildren, Nicole Casey (her special granddaughter), Anthony and Dawn Gentile, Andrew Gentile, and Angelo Gentile; and her great-grandchildren, Erika, Miranda, Adriana, Mikayla, Nicky, Joey, Grace, and Jaelyn.
