



Anthony P. Carcone

July 29, 1918 - April 16, 2011

Mr. Anthony P. Carcone, age 92, a longtime Utican, passed away on Saturday, April 16, 2011 with his loving family by his side. His passing occurred in the comfort of the home of his daughter and son-in-law in Victor, NY where he had most recently resided.

Born in Utica on July 29, 1918, Anthony was the son of the late Mariano and Mary (D'Amanda) Carcone. He was raised in Utica and attended local schools. A proud veteran of World War II, he honorably served his country in the Army Air Corps stationed in Europe, Africa, and the Middle East. On June 28, 1947 he married Ann Lewis with whom he shared 63 years in a perfect union of mutual love and devotion; throughout their life together, they were never apart. His beloved Ann passed away on December 8, 2010.

Anthony worked as an inventory management officer at the Griffiss Air Force Base for over 25 years, retiring in 1970. The focus of his life always remained with his family and providing for their needs. He loved them so much and treasured the time he spent with them, especially his grandchildren. Among his hobbies, he was an avid coin collector. He was a member of the Disabled American Veterans (D.A.V.) Stars & Stripes Chapter #82, and the American Legion. At one time he was a parishioner of St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church. Anthony is survived by his daughter and son-in-law, Linda A. and Anthony J. Barbato of Victor, NY; his son, Mark A. Carcone of Utica; his grandchildren, Joseph and Megan Barbato of Pittsford, NY, Anthony Barbato and Christopher Barbato, both of Victor, NY, Jodie and Gregg Ghrist, and Laurie Walker, all of

Simi Valley, CA; and great-grandchildren, Joey and Anna, Cynthia and Victor, MacKenzie and Casey, and Mario and Landon. In addition, he leaves many nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins, and in-laws, Lucretia Carcone, David Conti, and Gloria Lewis. He was predeceased by his brothers and sister-in-law, Mario "John" and Carmella Carcone, and Benedict "Ben" Carcone; his sisters and brother-in-law, Valentine Conti, Rose M. and William V. Monopoli; and his in-laws, Isabel Currier, Violet and Jack Mack, and Frank Lewis.
