



Mr. Anthony J. Jabour

November 13, 1927 - July 17, 2017

UTICA - Mr. Anthony J. Jabour, age 89, passed away peacefully on Monday, July 17, 2017 at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center with his loving family by his side.

Born in Clark Mills, NY on November 13, 1927, Anthony was the son of the late Naseem and Zaheya "Sadie" (Abdulla) Jabour. He was raised and educated locally and attended Utica Free Academy. A proud veteran of the United States Army, Tony honorably served his country as an Engineer in the 516th Special Brigade Company from 1950-1952 during the Korean Conflict. For his merits, Tony was awarded the Korean Service Medal with 2 Bronze Campaign Stars. He was married to Marion Eddo and to that union came the blessing of five children. Marion passed away on October 1, 2016. Tony accepted a position at the Charles Alt Construction Company where he joined the Carpenters Union Local #120 and passed through the career chain from apprentice to journeyman to master carpenter. He credits his accomplishments to his mentor Charles Alt. Tony was a finish carpenter for 36 years while working with H.R. Beebe Construction Company. At home, he was a part of his children's and grandchildren's lives, always there to guide and give advice. Tony loved his Lebanese heritage and ethnic foods, especially kibbe, and grape leaves. He could be counted on for any task needed and was the behind the scenes man for his family's business, Toma's Deli. He enjoyed golfing and fishing, as well as being the family photographer. Tony had a strong faith in God, and in earlier years he did a great deal of work and

repairs at his beloved parish, St. Louis Gonzaga Church. As quoted from one of his children “he could fix a rainy day”... and each of them have memories of special moments with their Dad and Giddo.

He is survived by his children and their loved ones, Connie Neupert and Ed Ozog, Beth and Joe Servello, Teresa and Rick Blank, Mary Ann and Steve Powers, and Anthony Jabour; he was beloved Giddo to his grandchildren, Rebecca and Mike Cheney; Jennifer and Chris Apgar, and Michael Servello; Ryan Blank, Collin Blank; Chris Powers, Andrew Powers; Zachary Wallace, Anthony Jabour, and Aubree Jabour; his sisters, Marion Kempf, and Amelia Jabour; and his longtime companion, Mary Miller. He also leaves many nieces, nephews; great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins, in-laws; and the many wonderful friends who blessed his life. He was predeceased by his brother, William Jabour; and his brother-in-law, Oscar F. Kempf.

Military Honors will be conferred by the United States Army. Entombment will follow in Calvary Cemetery Mausoleum.
