



## Anthony J. Loreti

August 12, 1930 - December 8, 2012

Mr. Anthony J. "Tony" Loreti, age 82, of Utica, passed away peacefully on Saturday, December 8, 2012. Born in Utica on August 12, 1930, Anthony was the son of the late Frank and Theresa (Massago) Loreti. He was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. A proud veteran of the United States Army, he honorably served his country during the Korean Conflict. On March 19, 1960 in Italy he married the former Antonietta Mazza with whom he shared his heart and soul for 52 years.

At one time, Anthony held a position with Friedrich International and later retired from the Utica State Hospital. Upon leaving the work force, he enjoyed his time under the employ of the Utica City School District at T.R. Proctor High School, a position he thoroughly enjoyed and for which he was well-suited. Anthony was a family man devoted to his wife, children, and grandchildren, and he shared a deep concern for their well being.

Anthony is survived by his lovely wife, Antonietta; his daughters and son-in-law, Teresa and Michael Doyle of New Hartford, and Camille Loreti of Utica; his son, Frank Loreti of Utica; and his adored grandchildren Amanda Doyle, and Michael Doyle who were the loves of his life. He also leaves his sister, Catherine M. Loreti of Utica; his in-laws in Italy; his childhood friend, Louie Damelio; and Erica Chaparro, who was like a granddaughter. He was predeceased by his brother, Peter Loreti; his sister and brother-in-law, Mary and Joseph Romeo; and his childhood friend, Jay Trisolino.
