UTICA - Mr. Anthony A. "Tony" Marchetta, age 95, passed away on Thursday, October 27, 2022 with his loving family at his side.

Born in Utica on March 23, 1927, Anthony was the son of the late Donato and Teresa (Romano) Marchetta. Raised and educated locally, he was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. A member of the Greatest Generation, Tony was a proud veteran of the United States Navy and a patriot who served his country with honor. Upon completion of his military duties, he furthered his studies at Champlain College and then the University of Kentucky where he received a Bachelor's degree in Business Administration. On August 11, 1962 Tony married the former Esther Julia Lenuzza and together they shared 59 years prior to Esther's passing on July 10, 2021. Theirs was a wonderful life filled with magical moments and beautiful memories.

Tony, along with his brother Joseph, owned and operated March Central Laboratories, Inc. for many years. They prided themselves in offering personal and precise service. A gentle man and a gentleman to all, Tony possessed a sense of humor that pleased everyone who crossed his path. His tidbits of wisdom and money saving tips inspired his family to follow his advice. His unique logic and witticisms will remain in the hearts and minds of those he loved.

In looking back on his years with Esther, Tony was grateful for the gift of faithful friends and family members, a circle of loved ones who happily ventured through life together. They enjoyed ski outings, a sport they pursued

into their 70's, and inspired their children to join in their retirement activities including tennis that Tony played with his brother-in-law Bill, golf, and their Bocce group. Tony looked forward to meeting his buddies every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday at the Marr-Logg Restaurant.

Tony loved his time as a member of the local Italian choir, Il Coro Italiano, and he honored his Catholic faith as a parishioner of St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church.

Tony is survived by his daughters and sons-in-law, Mary and Tom Primero, and Nancy and Scott Fiaschetti; his son, Michael Marchetta and Julie Cunningham; grandchildren, Michael and Clarizza Gasbara; Luca Fiaschetti, and Marco Fiaschetti. He was proud that his grandson Michael was recently wed to Clarizza and that they would be expecting a great-grandson in February. He also leaves his nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins; in-laws, Frances and Louis Bell, William "Bill" and Mildred "Millie" Lenuzza, and Lucy Lenuzza and the late Robert J. Lenuzza; and many special friends.
