UTICA - Mr. Anthony Joseph Scalise, Jr., age 76, passed away on Tuesday, January 21, 2020 with his loving family by his side.

Born in Utica on November 8, 1943, Anthony was the son of the late Anthony Joseph Sr. and Louise (Florenz) Scalise. Raised and educated locally, he was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. A veteran of the United States Army, Anthony was proud to serve his country. In 1973 he married the former Congetta A. Donato with whom he shared 47 years in a loving and devoted union.

Anthony worked as a United States Postal Carrier, the position from which he retired after serving more than 38 years delivering mail to Utica residents. A patient, kind, respectful patriarch, he loved and cared for his wife, children, and grandchildren. 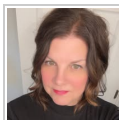
