Mrs. Antoinette Carmella (Graziano) Passante, age 89, passed away on Monday, December 8, 2014 at the Sitrin Health Care Center with her loving family by her side.

Born in Utica on October 28, 1925, Antoinette was the daughter of the late Santo and Maria (Coriale) Graziano. Raised and educated locally, she attended T.R. Proctor High School. She later continued her academic studies and received her Certification as a Licensed Practical Nurse (LPN). On May 24, 1947 she married Alfred T. Passante, Sr. with whom she shared a 58 year union. They were a loving, caring couple and together they upheld the Italian traditions of family values and Sunday dinners. Alfred passed away on November 24, 2005.

Antoinette was employed as a Nurse's Aide with the Masonic Care Community for many years. She was all heart, and her warm and friendly personality drew people to her. She was pleasant, polite, and eager to please. Her strength of spirit inspired those who shared her life. She was devoted to her family and welcomed all into her home. The love and interaction she shared with family and friends was fundamental to her personal happiness and nurturing nature. Antoinette was known for her Italian cooking. Her meatballs and fried dough were some of the best in town! She also crocheted and created blankets for her loved ones. During her leisure time, she cherished her canasta card parties with her friends, spending time with her sisters, and Bingo at the former Sons of Italy and the casino. She was a

communicant of St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church.

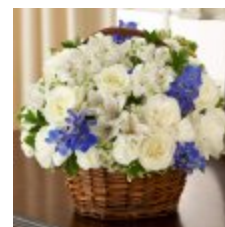
