Miss Antoinette M. "Toni" Salerno, age 92, of Utica, passed away on Monday, August 23, 2010 at the Charles T. Sitrin HCF with the love and support of her family.

Born in Utica on August 16, 1918, Antoinette was the daughter of the late Michael and Marguerita (Ritelli) Salerno. Raised and educated locally, she graduated from Utica Free Academy in the class of 1937. After relocating to Los Angeles in January of 1949 and employment opportunities which took her all over the world, she resumed permanent residence in Utica in April of 1984. In the interim prior to her return to the local area, Toni was employed with the U.S. government in various capacities and numerous locations, including both national and international placements. Over the course of her career, she was stationed in San Francisco, Washington DC, and overseas with assignments in such varied locales as Tripoli, Libya, Germany, and Italy. Her home parish was the Church of the Blessed Sacrament.
