UTICA – Mr. Arthur L. “Archie” Gaetano, Jr., age 76, passed away on Wednesday, January 29, 2025, and was reunited with his beloved relatives who had gone before him. At the time of his passing, his loving family was by his side.

Born in Utica on June 14, 1948, Archie was the son of the late Arthur L. Sr. and Carol (Bruni) Gaetano. He was raised and educated locally and graduated from New Hartford High School. Archie would later go on to cosmetology school after honorably serving his country in the United States Navy.

On June 11, 1977, Arthur wed the former Antoinette Marie Marino. They were the best of friends throughout their nearly 28-year blessed union. The two were truly inseparable! They had the utmost respect for each other and relished their unique love for one another. Antoinette passed away on May 7, 2005. Archie was thankful to inherit his strong work ethic from his parents – they instilled in their children love and perseverance. He cherished fond memories of winters spent in Arizona with his parents and siblings.

He was outgoing, adventurous, and energetic. People loved Archie for his honesty, loyalty, and work ethic. He was the dad everyone wanted to be around. He had a wonderful sense of direction and awareness, never getting lost on his travels with his friends. He was the man who ensured everyone around him was safe, even though he himself could be a bit of a risk-taker.

An automobile enthusiast, Archie had a passion for cars, particularly Corvettes. He also relished time spent building motorcycles and even built a special one for his good friend, Evel Knievel. In the winter, he broke out the snowmobiles, and in the summer, he enjoyed jumping on water skis and partaking in other summer ventures to various amusement parks with his family.

Archie later found companionship with Sharleen M. Randall, who passed away on September 30, 2023. The two found each other at just the right time and cared for one another for several years. He was fortunate to share a bond with Sharleen's daughter, Melissa Capristo.

Archie was a faithful believer in God throughout his life.

Archie is survived by his precious daughter, Ana Gaetano (her late fiancé Gus Bullock, who passed away on December 10, 2022); grandchildren, Amyah Bullock, Gino Bullock, and his furry grandson, George; sister, Maria Harris;
