



## Mr. August J. Palmieri

UTICA - We are deeply saddened to announce the untimely passing of our beloved father, August J. Palmieri, who passed away on Sunday, July 30, 2023 after nearly completing 100 years on this earth.

He was the son of the late Attilio and Mary (Esposito) Palmieri. He was a graduate of T. R. Proctor High School. August served our country with honor and faithfulness in the Pacific Theater from 1943 to 1946 as a Paratrooper in the 11th Airborne Division, the “Angels.”

Upon his return to the United States, he married the love of his life, Jennie Colacicco. Together, in a lifetime 76-year union of love and respect, they raised three children, Marlene, Lynne, and Rodney who had predeceased them in 1969.

August was a dedicated employee of the former Abelove’s Linen Company, later known as Associated Textile, and then Sketchley Linen Company. His loyalty and dedication to his employment was to be commended and were a true portrait of his character. Beloved associates Tony Barbato, and David Abelove were like sons to him.

He always said “when you walk into a room, your reputation precedes you.” August taught his children love and respect by this motto. He always provided

stability at home in an old school Italian family environment. He will sadly be missed by his loved ones.

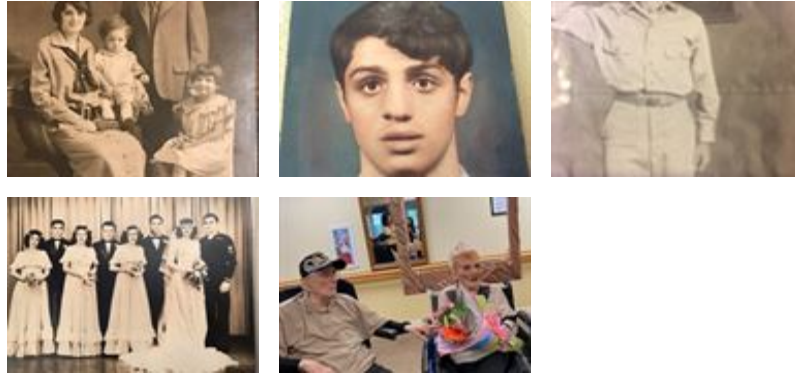
