UTICA – Mr. Barney L. Carter, age 81, went home to be with his loved ones and the Lord on Saturday, October 19, 2024, with his family by his side.

Born in Utica on May 5, 1943, Barney was the son of the late Charles and Flossie (Adams) Carter. After his mother passed away at a young age, Barney was raised by his maternal grandmother, the late Lucille Horn. He was raised locally and attended Utica Free Academy. Barney was proud of his time in the U.S. Army, where he served as a cook.

At one time, Barney wed the former Elizabeth A. Jackson, a union which blessed him with two children. He then found love with Gertrude “Gert” Gilmore, and two more daughters were added to their family. The couple shared a special bond until her passing on October 7, 2016.

Barney held employment with Kelsey-Hayes Co. as a machinist until his retirement. He was a great dad who was always celebrating the special days and achievements of his loved ones. He cared for his brother, Raymond, during his lifelong battle with cerebral palsy, prior to Raymond’s passing in 2012. Barney held a tremendous sense of responsibility to those he loved. Most days were started with a call to his sister, Annette, usually assisting illegible her with her lottery numbers.

A testament to Barney's days in the Army, he loved cooking, especially pasta. He was famous for his lasagna! He enjoyed sports, and particularly would be heard rooting for the Philadelphia Eagles and New York Mets. He was a member of St. Paul's Church.

Barney treasured the memory of his daughter, Antoinette M. "Momma" Carter, who passed away on October 27, 2012. He is survived by his children, Kira Gilmore, Victoria A. Gilmore, and Scott Carter; daughter-in-law, Sharon Henderson; grandchildren, Tyrell Carter; Shamel, Taurean, Jarvis; Jasmine, Yanique, Ja'Sona, and Nevaeh; 12 great-grandchildren; and siblings, Annette McClary, Rodney, Carter and Steven Carter. He fondly remembered his siblings who preceded him, James Carter, Willie Carter, Charles "MC" Carter, Jr., Raymond Carter, twin sisters, Rose Carter and Ruby Carter, and Thelma J. "Foxy" Carter. He further leaves his memory to a host of nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, and cousins; and many special friends. He was additionally predeceased by his great-nephew, Donnell L. Davis.
