



## Camille A. (Fanelli) LaFluer

Mrs. Camille A. (Fanelli) LaFluer, age 66, of Utica, passed away on Saturday, December 27, 2008 at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center with the love and support of her family.

Born in Canastota, New York on December 26, 1942, Camille was the daughter of the late Anthony and Antoinette (Giglio) Fanelli. Raised and educated locally, she was a 1960 graduate of T. R.
