April 18, 1920 - November 22, 2010

Mr. Carl A. Alberico, age 90, of Utica, passed away on Monday, November 22, 2010 in the comfort of his home with his loving family by his side.

Born in Utica on April 18, 1920, Carl was the son of the late Daniel and Palma (Dolcenome) Alberico. Raised and educated locally, he attended T.R. Proctor High School and during the Great Depression, he found employment opportunities in the Civilian Conservation Corps. On January 8, 1946 he married the former Alice Shufran with whom he shared 53 years prior to her passing on April 9, 1999. Carl was an unassuming and unpretentious man, and during their married life, he and Alice respected each other and worked toward the wellbeing of their family.

Carl retired from Chicago Pneumatic with over 23 years of dedicated employment. He was mechanically inclined and those who knew him referred to him as "Mr. Fix-It". He was a soft spoken man of simple needs, a patriarch who enjoyed helping and guiding his family. He led by example in his generosity, understanding, and acceptance of all. During his spare time, he found pleasure in playing poker with his pals. He practiced his Catholic beliefs and tried to do good by his fellow man. He was a parishioner of St. Mary of Mt. Carmel/Blessed Sacrament Parish.
