



## Mr. Carl A. Fuoco

January 28, 1917 - May 25, 2014

Mr. Carl A. Fuoco, age 97, passed away on Sunday, May 25, 2014 at the Katherine Luther Residential Health Care Center with the love and support of his daughter.

Born in Utica on January 28, 1917, Carl was the son of the late James and Rose (Giannotti) Fuoco. Raised and educated locally, he continued his education at Rider College in New Jersey where he received a Bachelor of Science degree. A veteran of World War II, Carl honorably served his country in the United States Army. On November 16, 1957 he married the former Kathleen J. "Kay" Emma with whom he shared 41 years prior to her passing on July 29, 1999.

Carl worked as a Project Manager for the Municipal Housing Authority, retiring in 1985. A professional, precise, and detail oriented employee he was committed to all his endeavors. Carl was a dutiful husband and father. Very soft spoken, he possessed the qualities of a fine gentleman.

He was a member of the Knights of Columbus for 65 years and of the American Legion Post #1290. He was a parishioner of Our Lady of the Rosary Church.

Carl is survived by his daughter, Rosemary Fuoco of Utica with whom he resided.
