Carl adored his family, particularly his sister Tresa, who became a second mother figure in his life. A giver at heart, Carl always enjoyed buying or making gifts for those he loved. Carl liked to hang out in his gazebo and also found pleasure in playing video games. He was a fan of watching the series, Knight Rider as well as the old Bruce Lee karate movies. He also loved his laptop and would take it almost everywhere with him. On weekends when his family brought him home, they would have nice family

dinners. His time was cut short, but all those who knew him are left with his love to last a lifetime and beyond.

Carl is survived by his mother, Mary Ann; his sister and brother-in-law, Tresa and John Fitzgerald; and his brother, Eric Lattrell.
