



## Dr. Carlo Thomas LoGalbo

October 28, 1941 - August 13, 2013

Dr. Carlo Thomas LoGalbo, age 72, passed away suddenly on Tuesday, August 13, 2013 in the dignity and comfort of his home with his loving family by his side, following a brief illness.

Born in Utica on October 28, 1941, Carlo was the son of Mary J. (Blando) and the late Russell S. LoGalbo. Raised and educated in Utica, he was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School. He pursued his collegiate studies at Syracuse University where he earned a Bachelor of Science degree. He then completed his Medical Doctorate degree at the University of Bologna.

Dr. LoGalbo practiced medicine in various locations throughout the United States, Europe, and Micronesia. A man of knowledge, distinction, and decorum, he held a great devotion to his family and most significantly, his mother. He was a 35 year member of the Knights of Columbus. A very spiritual and religious man, Carlo was a daily communicant at his parish, St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church.
