Mrs. Carmelita V. (Notarianni) Marangi, age 77, formerly of New Hartford and currently a resident of The Pines at Utica, passed away on Tuesday, June 15, 2010 at the Faxton-St. Luke's Healthcare Center with her loving son by her side.

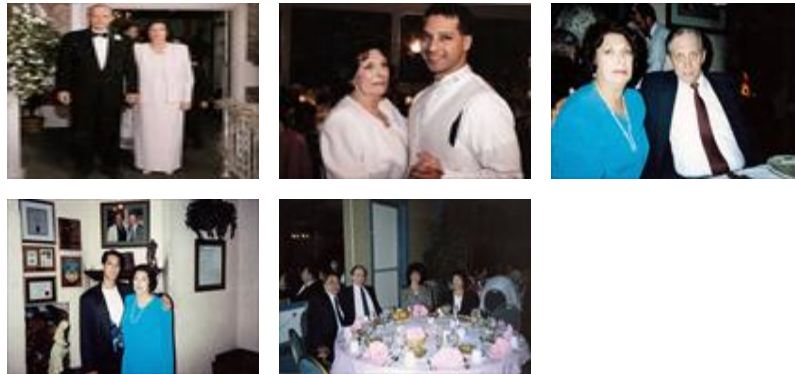
