



## Carmen Carl Pecheone

December 6, 1927 - May 15, 2008

Mr. Carmen Carl Pecheone, age 80, of Utica, passed away on Thursday, May 15, 2008 at the Masonic Care Community of NY with his loving family by his side.

Born in 1927, Carmen was the son of the late Carmine and Jennie (Grande) Pecheone. 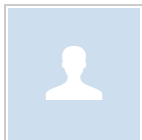
