mainly a homebody, but Sundays were her grocery shopping days. She was of the era where you never missed the local news followed by the national news. Her Saturday night entertainment was the Lawrence Welk Show, and her other favorites were Hee Haw, Happy Days, Laverne and Shirley, I Love Lucy, and especially Wheel of Fortune that she watched with a big bowl of popcorn by her side. Saturday night was also 'pizza night', and if it wasn't homemade, it was ordered from Rosario's Pizzeria on Welsh Bush Road. She was a cat lover and had several that she treated like family. During her stay at the Masonic Home, Carol had the benefit of a benevolent group of caregivers who were in tune to who she was and helped her to live a good life.

Carol is survived by her children, Michael McMullen, Irene Nichols, and David Nichols and fiancée Jennifer Morelle. Always close to her heart was the memory of her daughter Sharon McMullen who preceded her.
