Carol was born on June 25, 1940, to the late Thomas and Mildred (Washington) Medley. Carol was born and educated in Beacon, NY, a graduate of Beacon High School/Class of 1958. She was active in sports such as basketball and baseball, and was a member of the "Brockway Lassies."

Carol was an avid bowler as she was a league member, and she even became one of the top women bowlers in the Dutchess County area!

Although she grew up in St. Andrew's Episcopal Church in Beacon, NY, (where she was a trusted member for years) she came to love gospel music.

Carol worked as an Executive Assistant for Kraft Foods in White Plains, NY, for 40-plus years, from which she eventually retired. Although retired, Carol became a "Foster Grandparent" under the umbrella of MVCAA and began working at the North Utica Senior Center. There she worked with the all-day and after-school class children, with whom she immediately fell in love. She called them "her babies" and her eyes would light up when she spoke

about them. This was one of the greatest joys of her life. “Grandma” will truly be missed.

As a mother, Carol was admired for her determination, ambition, loyalty, spit-fire nature, and sometimes sharp tongue. “Nana” was intuitive, always knowing when the grandchildren needed to talk and was eager to share her wisdom and candid honesty. Additionally, she cooked for them in abundance and wanted them around as much as possible. The great-grands knew her as a teacher—reading time with her was precious.

A Wheel of Fortune addict, Carol was actually a contestant on the Wheel of Fortune in 1991! She won a substantial bounty with her luck.

Carol’s greatest joy, having a family, taught her the rewards of life through those relationships. A woman of faith through all her years, Carol currently attended Redeemer Church.
