



## Mrs. Carol Ann (Casab) Young

December 18, 1943 - August 15, 2018

UTICA - Mrs. Carol Ann (Casab) Young, age 74, passed away on Wednesday, August 15, 2018 at MVHS at St. Luke's Healthcare with her family by her side after a long and courageous battle with cancer.

She was born in Paterson, New Jersey on December 18, 1943, the daughter of the late Joseph Harris and Julia (Baker) Casab. She grew up on York Street in West Utica, attended Kernan Elementary School, and graduated from Utica Free Academy. On September 5, 1966 she was united in marriage with Leland K. (Lee) Young, Jr. at St. Basil's Melkite Catholic Church in Utica.

Carol had a secretarial career which began at the Boston Store and ended at MVCC, the position from which she retired. She loved God, her family, her flowers, her many trips to Maine, and her summers at the camp at Inlet, NY.
