



Caroline (Lucia) Chambrone

February 28, 1913 - February 19, 2008

Mrs. Caroline (Lucia) Chambrone, age 94, of Utica, passed away on Tuesday, February 19, 2008.

Born in Utica on February 28, 1913, Caroline was the daughter of the late Antonio and Catherine (Renzi) Lucia. She was raised and educated locally. On August 9, 1937 she married Joseph V. Chambrone, with whom she shared 47 years prior to his passing on July 4, 1985. The couple shared in an insightful relationship that revolved around family and devotion to one another. Caroline was a woman of strong character and a truly independent nature. She made herself available to be of help to her children and their families especially in the capacity of "babysitting". She was so proud of her grandchildren and the following generations, and was always concerned about what was happening in their lives. A fine cook, Caroline made the largest meatballs that just melted in your mouth, and she appreciated a good meal complemented by a glass of wine. She cherished the memories of the days spent at camp in Old Forge where she enjoyed horseback riding and fishing. In fact, she had a strong attachment and fondness for animals, and always had pets in her home. As a pastime, she took pleasure in playing cards with her friends. She was a communicant of St. Mary of Mt. Carmel/Blessed Sacrament Parish.

Caroline is survived by her son and daughter-in-law, Joseph A. Sr. and Frances Chambrone of Utica. She was predeceased by her two daughters and a son-in-law, Mary Ann and Anthony Lewis, and Eleanor Tartaglia Velardi,

and by her step-son, Louis Chambrone. In addition, she leaves her grandchildren, Rosemary Ajaeb, Joseph A. 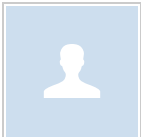
