UTICA – Mr. Claudio L. “Aleman” Garcia, age 85, passed away unexpectedly on Thursday, March 20, 2025. At the time of his passing, he was in the comfort and dignity of his home surrounded by his loving family.

Born in Jánico, Dominican Republic on February 9, 1940, Claudio was the son of the late Antonio and Anna (Collado) Garcia. As a young child, he recognized the importance of education and enjoyed furthering his knowledge whenever an opportunity prevailed. Despite various factors, Claudio was proud to have graduated from high school. Immediately following graduation, he began working to help support his family. He later relocated to the United States and continued his studies at Apex Technical School in New York, NY. He was grateful to become an American citizen, and for the opportunities it afforded him.

Claudio built a family of his own, fathering five deeply cherished children. A man of unwavering strength and integrity, he dedicated his life to caring for those he loved. He worked tirelessly as a Mechanical Supervisor at Ohio Bag in Manhattan and later, New Jersey, for over 40 years. He always provided the resources and support needed to raise his children and allow them to chase their dreams. He emphasized the importance of education and hard work in their hearts and minds. His greatest joy in life was knowing that he paved the way for his children to receive a higher education and seeing them grow into

successful adults.

Claudio was a stern gentleman, firm in his convictions. He dressed to impress, even when spending the day at home. He also was convinced that grilling at the beach was equivalent to preparing a gourmet meal. He loved a good debate! Additionally, Claudio was a generous man. As a jack of all trades, he took great pride in his ability to help those around him. He often built – and sometimes overbuilt – furniture such as his children’s bed frames. An extra screw or unnecessary bolt might be found but the fixture was forever stable! His love extended far beyond his immediate family as he shared mutual admiration with all his relatives and friends. Birthdays were always made into a special occasion for those Claudio loved.

Claudio is survived by his devoted partner, Maria Martinez; daughters, Anne Ernest, Claudia Garcia, and Julie Garcia; sons, Leonel “Lee” Garcia, and Osvaldo “Anthony” Garcia; daughter-in-law, Raquel Disla; numerous siblings, with special mention to his brother and sister-in-law, Victor and Carmen Garcia; and many grandchildren, great-grandchildren, nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins, and friends. Claudio was predeceased by many relatives and friends whom he was reunited with in Heaven.
