Mrs. Concetta G. "Connie" (Greco) Siringo, age 91, most recently of Punta Gorda, FL, passed away on Thursday, April 2, 2015.

Born in Utica on July 31, 1923, she was the daughter of the late Fortunato and Francesca (Scalzo) Greco. Connie received her education in local schools.

June 16, 1948 marked a special day in the lives of Connie and Carmen A. Siringo, for this is when they began a journey of 40 years of marriage. Their togetherness and regard for family life, along with mutual respect proved to be a blessing that lasted Connie a lifetime; her beloved Carmen passed away on January 4, 1989.
