Mrs. Cora (Pisano) Folino, age 90, of Utica, passed away on Thursday, August 5, 2010 at the St. Elizabeth Medical Center with the love and support of her family.

Born in Utica on October 13, 1919, Cora was the daughter of the late John and Rochitella (Diprisia) Pisano. Raised and educated locally, she was a 1937 graduate of Utica Free Academy and then attended the Utica School of Commerce. On June 14, 1941 she married Frank E. Folino, Sr. with whom she shared 39 years in a close and loving union filled with mutual love and respect. Frank passed away on October 11, 1980.

During her working life, Cora was employed by the General Electric Company Radio Receiver Plant for fifteen years. She also held a position as secretary for a local carpenters' union and builders' exchange. A loving, caring woman, Cora welcomed everyone into her home and her door was always open. She was a generous, selfless matriarch who devoted herself to her family, especially her cherished grandchildren. She will be remembered for her supportive nature, generous spirit, and sense of humor. At home, she was queen of the stove, known for her baking, cooking and especially her delicious meatballs. During her leisure time, she enjoyed solving crossword puzzles. She was a communicant of St. Anthony and St. Agnes Church.
