



## Daniel L. Pavese

October 2, 1929 - November 4, 2011

Mr. Daniel L. Pavese, age 82, of North Utica, passed away peacefully on Friday, November 4, 2011 at the Masonic Care Community of NY with his loving family by his side.

Born in Utica on October 2, 1929, Daniel was the son of the late Donato and Maria (Falatico) Pavese. Raised and educated in Utica, he attended M.V.C.C. after high school. A veteran of the United States Air Force, he served his country as an Airman 1st Class in the ranks of the Military Police. On July 11, 1973 he married the former Iris K. Pritchard with whom he shared 26 years until her passing on September 20, 2000; they were a loving couple, considerate of each other's needs and devoted to their children.

As a retired Captain of the Utica Fire Department, Daniel served for many years during his tenure with the Department. He directed and supervised the responses to fire, rescue, and medical emergencies for the city while demonstrating compassion and concern for all citizens in every emergent situation. He also retired from the Masonic Care Community of NY where he worked as a security officer, and additionally held employment as a manager with the Hudson Armored Car & Courier Service. Very loving and affectionate, Daniel was a man of great strength and wisdom, and he dearly enjoyed the time spent with his family, especially during the holidays. He was a true Renaissance Man, steadfast in his convictions, proud of his ancestry and historical traditions of his Italian heritage. He had an innate desire to gain knowledge and to that end, he was an avid reader. He was a gifted artist and

was also technologically minded and a member of the photography club, and the astronomy club. He maintained a more than 40-year affiliation with the Masonic Club, and at one time was the Past Master Mason of the Carducci Lodge #924 and a member of the Amicable Lodge #664. Currently, he belonged to the Oriental-Faxton Lodge #224. He was a parishioner of St. Anthony & St. Agnes Church.

Daniel is survived by his sons and daughter-in-law, Thomas Pavese of FL, and Michael and Judy Pavese of SC; his daughters and sons-in-law, Janice Pavese of Utica, Lisa and Todd Fuccillo of New Hartford, and Jodie and Charles DeCosty of Clinton. He also mourned the loss of his son, Vincent D. Pavese, who passed away on January 9, 1993. He also leaves his grandchildren, Cheryl and Wayne Perkins, Brianna Fuccillo, Alyssa Fuccillo, Erika DeCosty, and Jared DeCosty; and his great-grandchildren, Justin Perkins, and Tyler Perkins. He was blessed with many nieces, especially acknowledging Marie A.
