



Mr. David P. Tucci, Sr.

June 21, 1947 - August 6, 2024

MARCY - Mr. David P. Tucci, Sr., age 77, peacefully went home to be with the Lord on August 6, 2024, surrounded by his loving family. The family extends their heartfelt gratitude to friends, family, and the dedicated healthcare workers who provided care and support during this time.

Born in Utica on June 21, 1947, David was the son of the late Anthony and Amelia "Millie" (Cappelli) Tucci. He was a graduate of T.R. Proctor High School, Class of 1965, where he was the lead guitarist for the band "Bay 5." Music and performances were among the most cherished experiences of his life. David proudly served as an Army Reservist for six years at the Elihu Root Center located on Burrstone Road.

David married Maria Mauro on April 15, 1967, and together they celebrated 57 years of marriage. Their greatest joys were their two sons, David Jr. and Marc, and the life they built together as a family.

David joined his father at Tucci Maytag, which later became Tucci Home Appliance Center, and eventually moved to River Road in Marcy, adding a laundromat to the business. He shared his mechanical skills and passion for cars with David Jr., leading them to build and restore hotrods, with the '33 Willys being a notable achievement completed in 1988. David's love for food and creativity was passed on to Marc, who pursued art and culinary studies

and became a private chef for celebrities.

In 1980, David and Maria opened "La Frittata Trattoria," inspired by their love of Italian culture and cuisine. Their restaurant, known for its extensive frittata menu, grew from seating 15 to 125 people and included a garden for fresh ingredients.

In 1996, David Jr. launched Tucci Hot Rods with David Sr.'s encouragement. The business began showcasing at the Syracuse Nationals in 2000, where David Sr. and his friends served food to thousands, reflecting his joy in bringing people together. In 2016, his grandson Dominick joined the company, continuing the Tucci legacy of innovation and passion.

David also ventured into purchasing espresso machines and enjoyed traveling to Italy for this pursuit. His final business endeavor was opening the "Nice Car Storage Hotel" in 2008.

David was a member of the National Street Car Association, the Good Guys Car Club, and facilitated the "Misfit Club," where local business owners gathered for camaraderie and laughter. His creative and humble spirit was a blessing to all who knew him.

A devoted Christian, David gave his life to Jesus in 1981. He was a foundational member of Crosspoint Church, serving as a Deacon and Trustee for over 20 years. His inspirational messages were a source of daily encouragement for many.

David is survived by his beloved wife, Maria; sons and daughter-in-law, David Jr. and Jill Tucci, and Marc Anthony Tucci; grandchildren, Dominick, and Chelsea Tucci; and great-granddaughters, Amelia James, and Senna Lynn Tucci. He is also cherished by his brother, Anthony M. Tucci; sister, Angela Robinson (John), and their children; as well as many nieces, nephews, great-

nieces, great-nephews, cousins; and in-laws, Catherine and John Plado Costante, Salvatore and Michele Mauro, Gina and Joseph Burke, Dominick and Jean Mauro, and Anthony and Karen Mauro. David was predeceased by his paternal grandparents, Agricola and Angelina (DeRocco) Tucci; maternal grandparents, Angelo and Gilda (Saraceno) Cappelli; father-in-law and mother-in-law, Dominick and Rosalina (Frangiamore) Mauro; and brother-in-law and sister-in-law, Giuseppe "Joseph" and Giuseppina "Josephine-Pina" Mauro. David also knew the joys of many aunts, uncles, and cousins who will greet him in heaven.

The Tucci family wishes to extend their gratitude to Dr. Fred Talerico, a trusted physician and dear friend; hospitalist Dr. Victor Macias, who provided care in a kind, gentle, and compassionate manner; the staff of Wynn Hospital, who did everything they could to offer comfort to David and showed such respect and advisement to the family; and the staff of Hospice & Palliative Care, Inc., who were of great support when they were involved. Special caregivers made David and Maria's journey most comfortable with their abilities to relate to David: Debbie, who was remarkable; Nicole, who was gentle and caring; and Diane and Don who were most helpful. Also, the many visits by the pastors, and the many family and friends uplifted David's spirits on so many levels.

The family will receive visitors on Monday, August 19, 2024, from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. at Crosspoint Church, 317 Oriskany Blvd., Whitesboro. 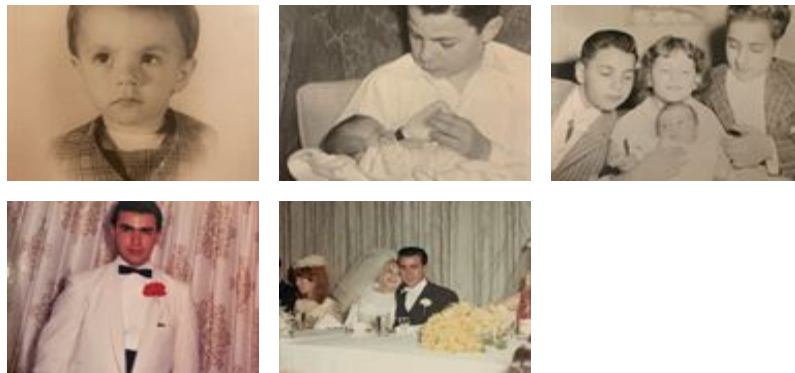
