At a young age, David was married to Joan Siegenthaler and to that relationship came the blessing of his 2 eldest children, David and Nicole. As friends, David and Joan came to better understand each other, and they remained true friends until the end. He entered into a subsequent relationship that gifted him a third child, Christopher. Ultimately, David was joined in a union of 27 years with the former Mary Giehl who gave birth to his youngest child, Jenna. Mary and David had the wherewithal to respect their bond and commitment as parents, and forged a tight-knit family focused on unity.

An extremely hard worker, David was endowed with a talent for mathematics, a great asset for his chosen job as a roofer. He precisely produced the materials needed when he was employed by Cobblestone Construction and Under Estimator Builders.

He was a handsome man who had a way with words that were so convincing, that he could surely change your mind.

In retrospect, Dave's intentions were always good. In each of his children and

grandchildren he saw their great potential and knew that their lives would be better than his, in regard to his own choices. A bit of reluctance was in his heart, but he hoped that he left each of those who loved him a bit of hope...
