Jerry became accustomed to Debbie’s ways in the early years and met all Debbie’s requests. When she became ill, Jerry couldn’t do enough to help. Debbie could always find work in service industries. At one time she worked with Petrone and Petrone as a legal secretary. She later held employment with the Chesterfield Restaurant where she partnered with the vision of Sal

Borruso. She also was a helpful hand and creative mind to her in-laws who operated the memorable Belvedere's Market. In April of 1996, she began as a waitress at Georgio's Village Café and quickly rose up the ranks to become manager, as well as a trusted and beloved friend and confidant to Judy Gorea.

She had a wonderful eye over everything in her life, which could be both a blessing and a detriment to her family and others. She was a gifted soul who touched and made a mark on so many people. She was honest and forthright, loyal and true to her commitments. She was never afraid to speak her piece. Everything Debbie touched had her memorable mark upon it. Whether through her wise words or her sometimes blunt statements, she stayed true to herself and always maintained control. Debbie was truly one in a million.

As a mother, she was also her son and daughter's best friend. She knew both of their hearts and wanted them to be the best that they could be. She wished for them to challenge themselves academically and build their individual characters. She took great care to be connected to them and was truly a passionate mama bear.

A fabulous cook, she was creative in her kitchen. One of the most unique things she did was in preparation for dinner for her husband and children, she would plate their meals to ensure they were well fed. Baking became a second art form for her. Her ability to prepare some of the most unique desserts was so impressive. Sentimentally, out of love for her Grandma Grasso, she was so proud to have had her treasured cookie recipes and to maintain the traditions that meant so much to her. Her passion for cooking was evident in her numerous freezers that were always well stocked. She also had the gift of being able to present her meals in a beautiful way. Her signature dish was her lasagna ~ the more ricotta, mozzarella, and meat the better – you had to be a weightlifter to carry it! One of Debbie's greatest enjoyments, in addition to those above, was travelling. She began in her youth

with friends and concluded with numerous trips with her brother and sister-in-law.

Debbie appreciated her parents, her brother, and all her extended relatives. Spending time with her family was of the utmost importance to her. She also loved her Enzo, their Golden Retriever who was always by her side and gave her security and joy.

When she received her diagnosis, she strove to keep things normal for her family's sake. She never complained and always said she was feeling great. She wanted normality above all else. She had such a positive attitude.

She never really knew how loved and well-regarded she was in this community. Her presence could truly light up a room. She humbly just took each day, gave it her very best, and worried about the things that were important to her. She impacted so many people with her vivacious, outgoing, and humorous ways. She had her last hurrah at her nephew and niece's wedding which will be so memorable to all.
