



Mrs. Debra Lee "Debbie" Hooks-Klar

Mrs. Debra Lee "Debbie" Hooks-Klar, age 44, of Rome, NY, passed away on Sunday, January 10, 2016 at the Roswell Park Cancer Institute after a courageous battle with Leukemia. At the time of her passing, her loving family was by her side.

Born at the US Naval Hospital, Subic Bay, Philippines on May 7, 1971, Debra Lee was the daughter of Crispin and Dionicia "Julie" (Alipio) Hooks. She was a graduate of Notre Dame High School and attended MVCC where she received her Associate degree in Graphic Design. On October 16, 2004 she married John E. Klar with whom she shared her love and devotion.

At one time, Debra Lee held employment at FiServ Banking and later accepted a position at Partners Trust Bank. More recently, she worked for the Bank of New York Mellon Corporation at the Oriskany branch in the International Loans Division up until her illness. Debra Lee always offered fidelity and a friendly smile to everyone in her circle of life. Wherever she went, she brought her benevolent nature with her, and lasting friendships were formed. She was a loving and caring wife and mother, a beautiful daughter, and a thoughtful, caring, and giving sister. She was a gifted and talented painter, and enjoyed camping. She excelled at bowling and was proud of the several bowling records she held locally. Debra Lee was always the party planner and the baker for family events, and added her unique touch to the gatherings.

Debra Lee is survived by her husband, John; her parents, Crispin and Julie

Hooks of Westmoreland; her sons, Jonathon C. Klar who she lovingly referred to as “Mini-Me”, and Dominic F. Klar who she affectionately called her “gordita”. She will remain in the hearts of her brother and sister-in-law, Dennis F. and Kimberly J. Bowman-Hooks of New Hartford; many aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, special cousins, in-laws, Tammy Bottini, Francis “Franny” Klar, Jr., and Louis “Louie” Klar; and many loving, dear friends. 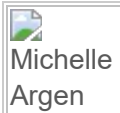
