



Domenico "Dominick" De Carlo Sr.

July 31, 1947 - June 20, 2013

Mr. Domenico "Dominick" De Carlo, Sr., age 65, passed away on Thursday, June 20, 2013 in the comfort and dignity of his home surrounded by the love and support of his family.

Born on July 31, 1947 in Alberobello, a small town bordering the Adriatic Sea in the province of Bari, Italy, Dominick was the son of the late Giovanni and Cosimina (Tramacera) De Carlo. He was raised and educated in Italy. As a young man on October 28, 1967, he immigrated to the United States and to Utica where he has since resided. On June 3, 1986 he married the former Michelle D. Stevener in Utica.

For only receiving a second grade education in Italy, Dominick was so proud to have accomplished such a fine career as owner and operator of De Carlo Plastering & European Ceiling Designs, Inc. He was a generous, and respected master craftsman and extraordinarily talented man. A plasterer by trade, he leaves behind many of his masterpieces. He will be greatly missed by all who knew him. At one time, he was a parishioner of St. Agnes Church and a member and past-president of the St. Cosmas & Damiano Society Chapel on Kossuth Ave.

Dominick is survived by his wife, Michelle; his 4 sons, Roberto/US Army Master Sergeant and Paula De Carlo stationed at the US Army Garrison in Bamberg, Germany, Domenico "Dominick" De Carlo, Jr. and Angela Arancio, Christopher/Sergeant US Marine Corps and Christina De Carlo, and Marco De Carlo; and his 4 grandchildren. In addition, he is survived by his brothers

and sisters-in-law, Vito and Juanita De Carlo, Cosmo and Evelyn De Carlo, and Mario and Carmela De Carlo; his sisters and brothers-in-law, Marta and Jake Cooper, and Pia and Vincent Brancaccio; as well as several aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews, cousins, and in-laws.

Dominick's family will honor and commemorate his life at a private Memorial Service which will take place at the convenience of the family.
